

Oklahoma Travel Show Debuts October 3, 2009 on My 41 in Tulsa

Two Wheel Oklahoma will travel the backroads and highlight destinations “off the beaten path” for television viewers.

Tulsa, OK— After two years of planning, writing and riding, an ambitious local duo are unveiling a new television program for Green Country viewers. Beginning October 3rd Two Wheel Oklahoma will air Saturdays at 9:00 am on Tulsa television KMYT-41. Viewers will ride along as Brad Mathison and Rex Brown tour Oklahoma by motorcycle. The show will feature local festivals, unusual places and interviews with local characters.

“It's not just a show about motorcycles,” Brad Mathison explained. “We just happen to be riding motorcycles.”

The majority of the show will focus on the highways, history and unique places that make Oklahoma special. The pilot episode features Claremore, Oklahoma and places like the Will Rogers Memorial. Future shows will visit destinations such as the Talimena Scenic Byway, Red Rock Canyon and Oklahoma's only railroad tunnel.

“We've been riding around this state all our lives,” Rex Brown told us. “But I'm constantly amazed how we always seem to discover something new. If you're looking for it, there's almost always something interesting just around the next bend.”

Viewers in Tulsa will have their chance to share in the discovery soon. Beginning October 3, 2009 the program will air every Saturday morning at 9:00 am on Tulsa TV station KMYT. KMYT-41, commonly known as My 41, is available on most cable and satellite carriers in Northeastern Oklahoma.
